
St Adobe Stock Artist Field Guide: Titles and Keywords for Stills and Videos

Updated March 2021

Title and keyword overview

Titles and keywords play a vital role in surfacing your content on Adobe Stock. This guide contains tips, tricks, and examples covering a variety of subjects that can be applied to photographs, illustrations, vectors, and videos. Here are some general tips to get you started:

- Titles should be concise—70 characters is ideal, although the system allows up to 200.
- Titles are searchable and become the URL.
- Include all the important words from the title in the top 10 keywords for an extra "bump" in search relevance.
- Brand names, product names, and people's names shouldn't appear in the title. People's names shouldn't appear in keywords.
- Keyword order matters, with the first 10 affecting search results the most. <u>Check out these tips</u> for using titles to create ordered keywords.
- Don't use uncommon phrases. If it wouldn't appear in a dictionary, it probably shouldn't be a keyword. For example, "monkey bars" would be in a dictionary, but "red dress" wouldn't.
- Nouns should be singular. For example, use "cat" instead of "cats."
- Adjectives should be descriptive, not subjective. For example, use "red" or "furry" or "sunny" but don't use "cute" or "sensual" or "beautiful."
- Simple is better—be descriptive, not verbose. The ideal number of keywords is 15 to 35, but please keep it under 50.
- o If you're aware of additional information such as ethnicity, age, or location, include these specifics in the keywords.



People

As you create appropriate and insightful titles and keywords for your work, you can celebrate your subjects while enhancing the search experience.

People keywords for inclusivity

- **Be transparent.** As your models are signing the release, communicate honestly about how the content may be used and how they'd like to be represented. Discuss the theme of the shoot and the concepts that may be associated with the content to optimize sales.
- **Be considerate.** Think about how you'd like to be described if you were the model. Practices like adding sensationalist, inflammatory, or overly spammy keywords are counterproductive.
- **Be accurate.** Words are powerful, especially when linked with imagery. Titles and keywords should accurately represent the content and shouldn't promote discrimination or perpetuate stereotypes.
- **Be factual.** Keywords related to sensitive personal information like ethnicity, nationality, gender, sexual orientation, age, relationships, and disabilities should be based on fact and supported by the model release or the model's own preferences. Don't assume, guess, or embellish.
- **Be mindful.** Try to avoid cultural appropriation in keywords and titles. Do your homework, especially if you're depicting people, places, or things outside your own culture. It's a good idea to speak to someone you know from a cultural group about the terminology used for representation.

More tips for people keywords

- Age/gender/ethnicity: Include a gender (e.g., man or woman), descriptive terms for age (e.g., mature, adult, or teen), and ethnicity/race (e.g., Asian, multiracial, or white). This information should be supported by the model releases provided and/or discussed with your models during the shoot.
- Sensitive information: Only include sensitive information such as sexual orientation or disabilities as verified by the model and if relevant to the content. Don't assume, guess, or embellish.
- Activity: What are the people doing? Use the root or infinitive form of the verb (e.g., run, jump, cook, or play).
- **Relationship or role:** Describe relationships and/or roles (e.g., father, couple, baker, or farmer). For real people, include the actual relationships or roles. For models, discuss possible roles for the shoot that may be relevant to the content.
- Facial expressions and appearance: Use keywords to describe facial expressions (e.g., smile, frown, or looking at camera) and appearance (e.g., blonde, brunette, dreadlocks, or tattoo).
- **Clothing:** Describe clothing if noteworthy (e.g., hat, sunglasses, or roller skates). No need to describe every piece of clothing on every person in the image.
- **Concepts:** Describe concepts demonstrated by the people in the image (e.g., childhood, togetherness, fitness, or healthcare).

Gender/age/ethnicity

Below are suggestions for representing a model's gender, age, and ethnicity/race using keywords. These are optional and the lists aren't exhaustive.





Object keywords

- **Type of object:** Use the most specific singular noun to identify the object (e.g., armchair, bottle, or wagon).
- **Object description:** Use adjectives to describe the object's pattern, color, texture, or condition.
- No people: If there are no people, always add "no people" and "nobody."
- Arrangement: Describe how the objects are arranged (e.g., row, random, stack, or still life).
- **Setting:** Is it indoors or outdoors? Day or night? What's the weather like?
- **Concepts:** Describe concepts associated with the object (e.g., competition, crime, or luxury).

Animal keywords

- Animal species: Be as specific as possible about the type of animal. Include the scientific name, species name, and/or common name (e.g., elephant, African elephant, and Loxodonta Africana). Be sure to keep the scientific name together as one concept or phrase—don't split it into individual words or parts.
- Number of animals: Describe the number of animals up to five and use group- and animal-specific terms (e.g., herd, flock, or gaggle).
- Animal gender: If male and female gender terms are differentiated within a species, include the gender-specific term (e.g., ewe, rooster, hen, or doe).
- Animal age: If the animal's age is apparent, add an appropriate descriptive keyword. Use the animal-specific word (e.g., calf, chick, or lamb).



Place keywords

- **Geographical location:** Be as specific as possible about the geographical location (e.g., Eiffel Tower, Paris, France). Only include location specifics that are verifiable through property release information or other trusted sources.
- **Type of place:** What type of place is it (e.g., farm, office, town, cemetery, or square)?
- Location description: Use additional words to describe the place (e.g., rural, urban, skyline, beach, desert, or mountain).
- Architectural: Is it an interior or exterior? Is there a specific architectural element (e.g., dome, balcony, door, or detail)?
- Setting: Is it indoors or outdoors? What's the time of day? Is there a noticeable season or type of climate or weather?

Plant and flower keywords

- **Type of plant:** Use the most specific term to describe the plant or flower, including the scientific name (e.g., Marigold, Calendula officinalis). Be sure to keep the scientific name together as one concept or phrase—don't split it into individual words or parts.
- Plant description: Use descriptive terms for the plant's appearance (e.g., bloom, lush, dewy, or spiny).
- **Plant detail:** Use common terms if you can identify parts of the plant that are prominent in the image (e.g., petal, blossom, stem, stalk, leaf, or seed).

- **Type of food:** Use the most specific singular noun to describe the food (e.g., pizza, apple, cocktail, or tiramisu).
- **Food description:** Use descriptive terms for the food's color, texture, taste, qualities, or cultural significance (e.g., green, fresh, savory, organic, Italian, or celebration).
- **Cooking technique:** If known, use words that describe the cooking technique (e.g., bake, grill, steam, or boil).
- **Conceptual or trend:** If applicable, use conceptual or trend keywords to describe the food (e.g., artisan, healthy, or indulgence).
- **Food-related objects:** Describe any important food-related objects (e.g., tajine, cutting board, or platter).

- **Conceptual or trend:** If applicable, use conceptual or trend keywords to describe the business (e.g., creative, artisan, or commercial).

Illustration keywords

- **Style:** Include keywords that describe the artwork. Here's the list:
 - Illustration keywords: illustration, art, and graphic
 - Vector keywords: vector, graphic, and—if applicable—icon
 - 3D rendering keywords: 3D, render, rendering, and digital

Also, include relevant keywords for art style or medium (e.g., watercolor or etching).

- Main subject: Describe the main subject of the illustration (e.g., dog, woman, or flower).
- Theme: Add keywords for relevant themes (e.g., Christmas, finance, or travel).
- **Supporting details:** Is anything else in the picture (e.g., bicycle, aardvark, ocean, or airplane)?
- Action: If applicable, describe the action (e.g., run, swim, or dance).
- Setting: Describe the place or time of day (e.g., underwater, Jupiter, night, or rainforest).
- Note: You don't need to include Latin or scientific names on cartoon-style illustrated plants and animals, but you can for scientific illustrations.





Overall, titles and keywords for video clips follow the same rules as still images, with the following exception: If the clip uses a special technique or camera angle (e.g., zoom, timelapse, or aerial), be sure to include it in the title and keywords. Check out the glossary at the end of this section for a list of terms and definitions.


